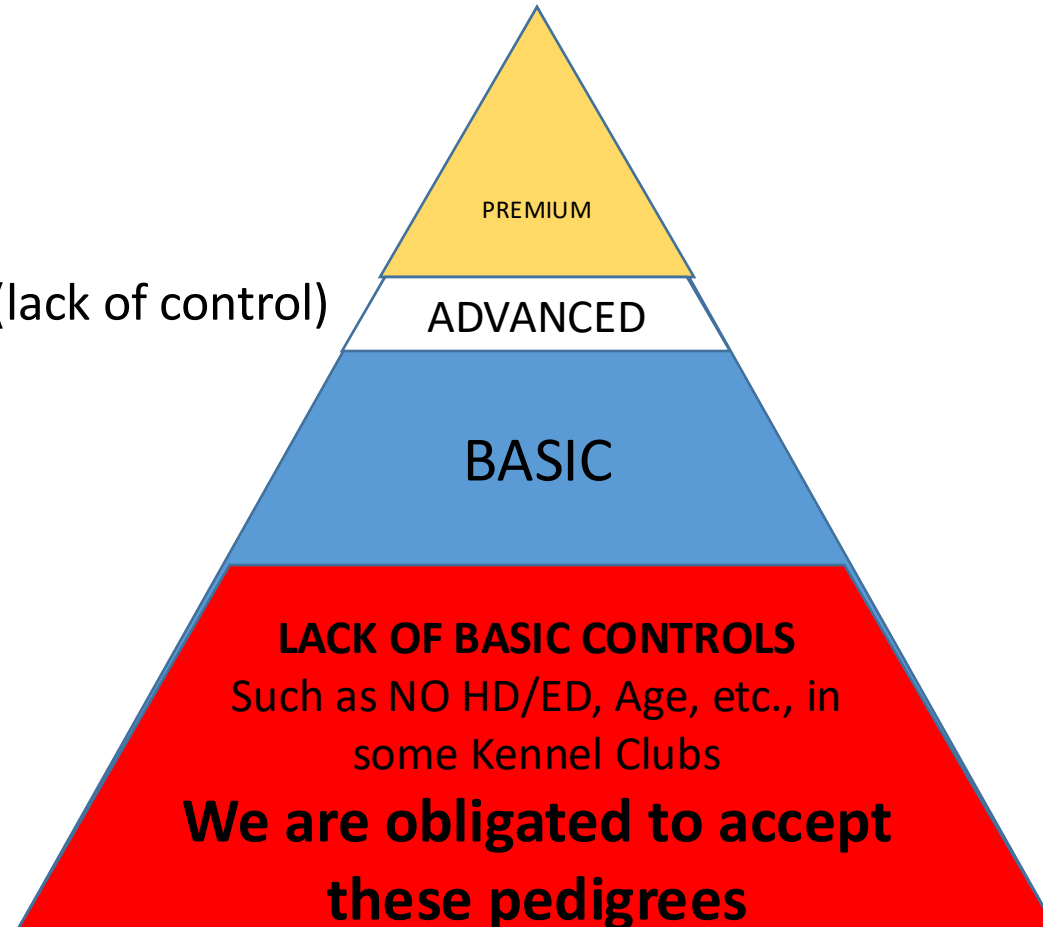

BACKGROUND



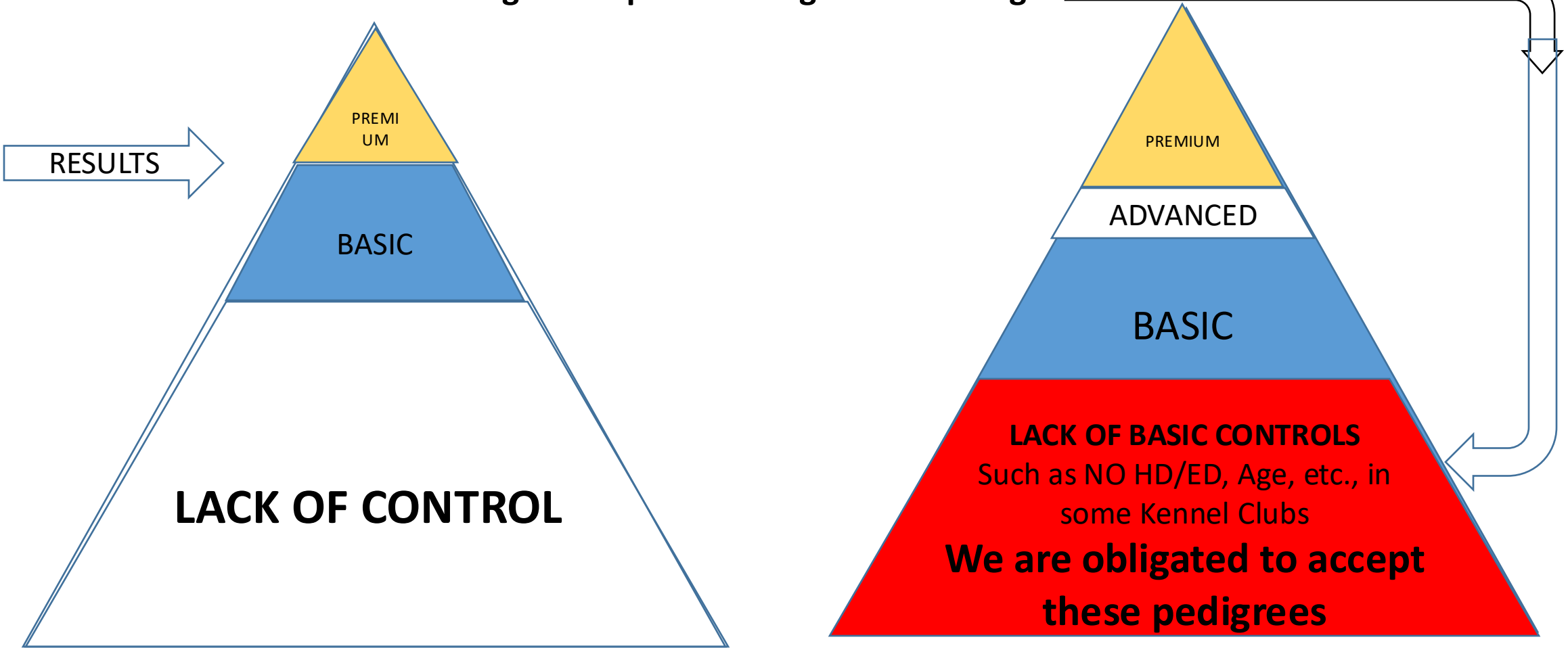
- 2019 Was approved the Harmonization Program, with the aim of having a global regulation for both: breeding and shows.
- New regulations regarding animal welfare.
- New trend, like adopting instead of purchasing.
- The decrease in numbers of litters.
- Some Kennel Clubs can also register the litters (lack of control)
- Non pedigree breeding (zero control)
- Etc.



RESULTS



- 2024 Vast majority of the clubs around the world can not comply and will not do it because then can not and breeders **have other recognized options to register their dogs** .

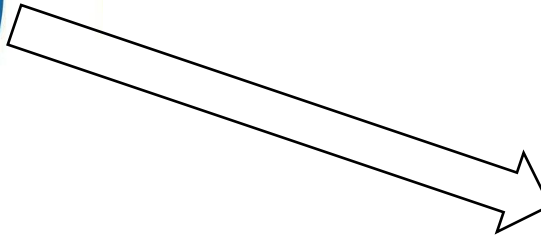

- LOCAL REGULATIONS ACCORDING TO THE POSSIBILITIES OF THE COUNTRIES
- ECONOMICAL ISSUES
- TESTS CAN BE DONE LOCALLY (HD/ED, DNA)

PROPOSAL TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY



- Extension of the deadline for the Harmonization program to come into force, starting 2027 or 2028 (6.4)
- During this period, draw up a new **Global Breeding and Show Program** accessible to all WUSV member clubs, **on the basis of think globally and act locally**. Such program will mandatory take into account the **Standard, Health, Temperament, Parentage and Judges**.
- Each country may have requirements higher than the basic ones, according to their needs.
- The show qualifications (VA & V) may take into account the characteristics of the countries or regions.
- Those who wish to present their dogs in Germany or any other country, should meet the requirements that the SV or the other country has at the time.
- The drafting of a **new program will be lead by the Breedwarden of the SV with the new working group** appointed by the Board of the WUSV, to present the new program to the Board of Directors of the WUSV and SV, and then present to the respective **General Assemblies of the SV and WUSV** as soon as possible.
